Code of Conduct - Head of the Hooch

ROWERS, COACHES, and **CHAPERONES** traveling as members of the South Orlando Rowing Association are required to adhere to the following **CODE OF CONDUCT**. When student–athletes travel as a member of the South Orlando Rowing Association, they agree to abide by the following rules:

- Unless specified by <u>Coach Terry</u>, all athletes must be in their assigned room for the night by 9pm.
- Social interaction between team members of the opposite gender must only take place in public areas. Rowers will not entertain members of the opposite gender in team-arranged hotel/motel rooms or other private settings.
- Rowers will not enter any hotel room other than the one they are assigned to, or their parents' room.
- Rowers are at regattas to row and their races and their team are their top priorities
- During practices and throughout the regatta, rowers are required to stay with their team unless <u>Coach Terry</u> approves an alternate activity. There will be no exploring, shopping, etc. unless approved by <u>Coach Terry</u>.
- Rowers are required to report on time for practices and races. Missing report times may result in being removed from racing lineups.
- SORA has ZERO tolerance for alcohol and drug possession or consumption. Any violation of this rule will result in immediate transportation home at the expense of the rower's family.
- Every SORA athlete agrees to comply with chaperones' directions and instructions.
- Schedule changes will be announced by <u>Coach Terry</u>. Rowers should never assume schedule changes. Any changes will be delivered directly by <u>Coach Terry</u> and will then be communicated over the Remind texting service.
- Any use of pool facilitates must first be authorized by Coach Terry.
